Gellyball at Mega Air is delivered as a **structured, rule-based team activity** designed specifically for **school groups**.

What Is Gellyball?

Gellyball is a **low-impact, non-paint marking activity** using soft, biodegradable gel projectiles. Unlike paintball, it is designed to be:

- Lower impact
- Cleaner (no paint or staining)
- Suitable for **underage school groups**
- Operated within strict safety rules

All equipment and sessions are managed by Mega Air staff.

How Gellyball Is Used in a School Context

Gellyball sessions are **not run as free play**.

They are delivered as **structured team scenarios** that require students to:

- Communicate clearly with teammates
- Follow rules and boundaries
- Make decisions under time pressure
- Take on defined roles within a group
- Demonstrate leadership and cooperation

This structure allows Gellyball to function as a **team-based learning activity**, rather than a purely recreational game.

Educational Value for Schools

Gellyball supports learning outcomes commonly sought in school activity days, including:

- Teamwork and collaboration
- Leadership and shared responsibility
- Strategic thinking and problem-solving
- Emotional regulation and self-control
