

Behaviour Expectations & Code of Conduct

Mega Air – School Activities & Events

This Behaviour Expectations & Code of Conduct applies to all school visits and events held at Mega Air, including activity sessions, school events, and underage social events.

The purpose of this code is to ensure **student safety, wellbeing, and positive participation**.

1. General Expectations

All students attending a school activity or event at Mega Air are expected to:

- Follow instructions from teachers and Mega Air staff
- Behave respectfully towards other students, staff, and equipment
- Participate safely and within the agreed rules
- Remain within designated areas at all times
- Support a positive and inclusive environment

2. Activity Behaviour Expectations

During activity sessions (e.g. bouncing, team activities):

Students must:

- Follow all safety briefings and rules
- Use equipment only as instructed
- Be aware of others and avoid unsafe behaviour
- Stop activity immediately if instructed

The following are **not permitted**:

- Rough play or physical intimidation
- Unsafe movements or misuse of equipment
- Ignoring staff or teacher instructions

3. Social & Event Behaviour Expectations

During school events or underage social events:

Students must:

- Remain within supervised areas
- Follow behaviour expectations set by the school
- Use facilities respectfully
- Engage appropriately with music, lighting, and event spaces

The following are **not permitted**:

- Running in crowded areas
- Pushing, shoving, or unsafe dancing
- Inappropriate language or behaviour
- Use of unauthorised items

All events are **alcohol-free** and **substance-free**.

4. Respect & Inclusion

Students are expected to:

- Treat others with respect
- Include peers and avoid exclusionary behaviour
- Respect differences in ability, confidence, and participation levels

Bullying, harassment, or discriminatory behaviour will not be tolerated.

5. Teacher Authority & Supervision

- Teachers retain authority over students at all times
- Students must follow teacher instructions immediately
- Mega Air staff support behaviour management and may intervene where safety is concerned

6. Consequences of Unsafe or Inappropriate Behaviour

If behaviour does not meet expectations:

- A student may be reminded of expectations
- A student may be removed from an activity or event
- A student may be required to sit out under supervision
- In serious cases, a student may be excluded from further participation

Any consequences are managed by the school, with support from Mega Air staff as required.

7. Serious Incidents

Serious incidents (including aggression, refusal to follow instructions, or behaviour that risks safety) may result in:

- Immediate removal from activities
- Contact with school leadership
- Early departure from the venue, if required by the school

8. Acknowledgement

By attending a school activity or event at Mega Air, students are expected to comply with this Behaviour Expectations & Code of Conduct.
