

Sample School Event Timetable

Mega Air – School Activities & Events

This sample timetable demonstrates how a school event or activity day at Mega Air may be structured.

Timings and activities are indicative and can be adjusted to suit school requirements, group size, and year level.

Example: Combined Activity + Social Event

(Bouncing + BBQ + Supervised Social Event)

09:45 – Arrival & Entry

- School group arrives at Mega Air
- Students enter as a supervised group
- Teachers conduct initial roll check
- Bags and personal items stored as directed

10:00 – Welcome & Safety Briefing

- Staff welcome the group
- Clear explanation of:
 - Behaviour expectations
 - Safety rules
 - Activity flow and transitions
- Students allocated into supervised groups

10:15 – Supervised Bouncing Session

- Timed, closed-session bouncing activity
- Activity delivered within defined zones
- Teachers and staff positioned throughout

- Water breaks encouraged as required

11:15 – Session Close & Transition

- Bouncing areas closed to students
- Groups transition together under supervision
- Roll check completed
- Short rest and water break

11:30 – Lunch / BBQ Break

- Students move to BBQ and courtyard area
- Lunch eaten in designated spaces
- Teachers supervise eating and social time
- Opportunity for informal check-ins and rest

12:15 – Transition to Function Room

- Groups move together to the function room
- Roll check completed
- Behaviour expectations reinforced

12:30 – Supervised Social / Event Session

- Structured social time in the Mega Red Giant Function Room
- Music, visuals, and lighting appropriate for age group
- Stage available for announcements if required
- Teachers remain actively supervising
- Mega Air staff support event flow and equipment

13:30 – Wind Down & Event Close

- Music volume reduced
- Students seated or grouped

- Final announcements or acknowledgements
- Preparation for departure

13:45 – Departure

- Final roll check
- Supervised exit from venue
- Group departs as planned

Notes for Schools

- This timetable is **indicative only**
- Final timings are confirmed during planning
- Activity-only or event-only formats are also available
- Transitions are deliberately structured to support behaviour and safety
- Schools retain overall supervision responsibility throughout

Alternative Timetable Options

Schools may also choose:

- Activity-only visits (bouncing or Gellyball)
- Shorter or longer social events
- Assembly, prizegiving, or showcase-only formats
- Split sessions for large cohorts
